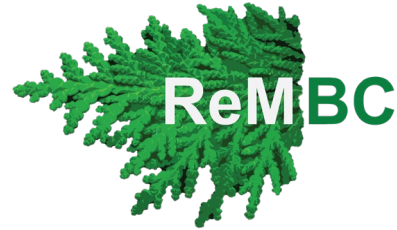

Impact Evaluation: 2016 - 2022

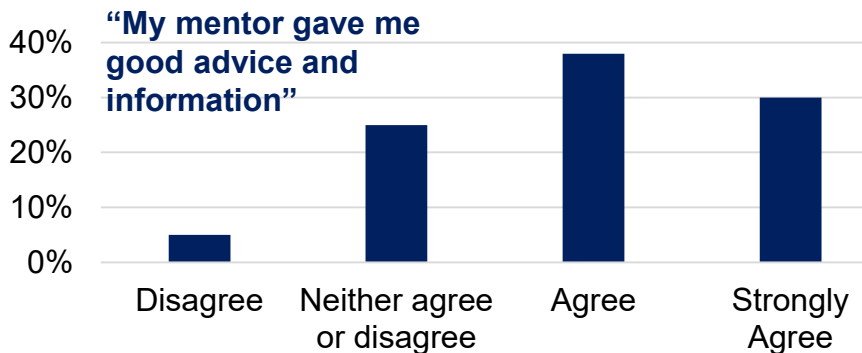


Program Vision: Through near-peer mentorship, we support pathways to post-secondary education and healthcare careers for rural students.

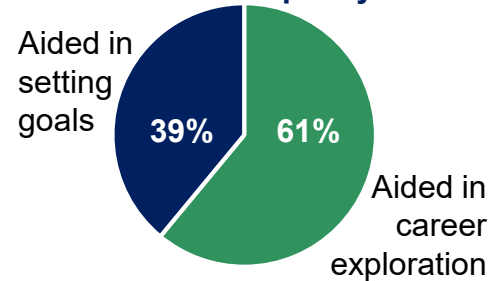
Program Goals:

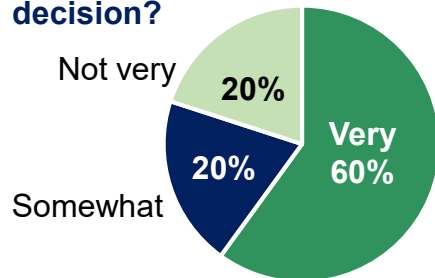


How did ReMBC impact your life?

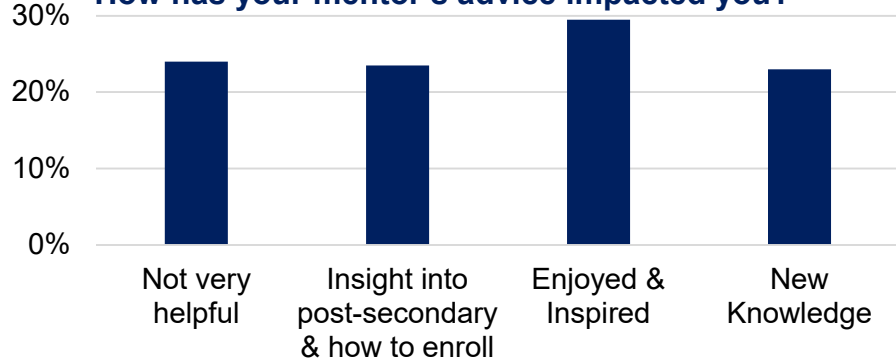


Knowledge Gained

Was ReMBC helpful for your post-secondary education decision?

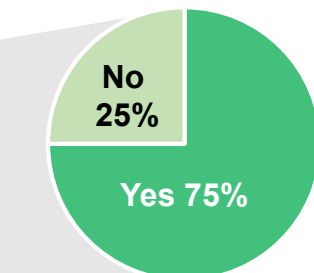
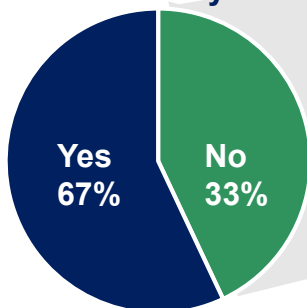


How has your mentor's advice impacted you?



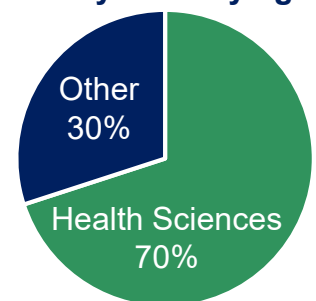
Long-term impacts – what we heard from past participants

Have you enrolled in post-secondary?



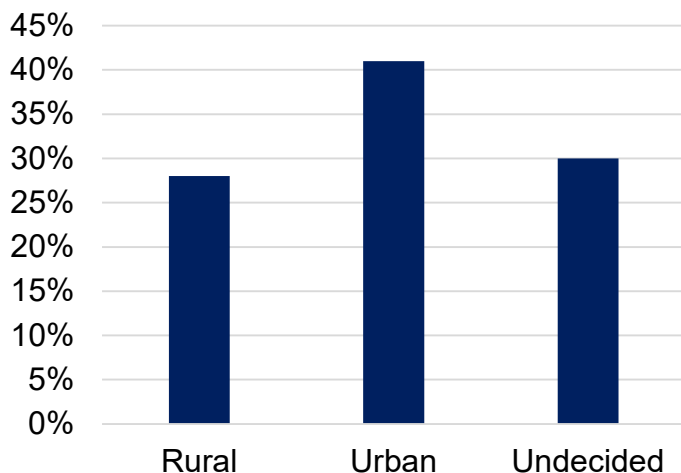
Do you intend to pursue post-secondary education?

From Rural to Urban

After completing high school, would you prefer to work and live in an urban or rural area?



Summary:

- Rural youth viewed the program positively:
 - Most thought their mentor gave them good advice.
 - Most felt the program helped them set goals and plan for the future.
- Rural youth gained:
 - Information that helped them make decisions about post-secondary.
 - Knowledge and inspiration from their mentor.
- Long-term impacts - educational status of past-participants:
 - Most have enrolled or intend to enroll in post-secondary.
 - Most past-participants who are enrolled in post-secondary are studying health sciences.

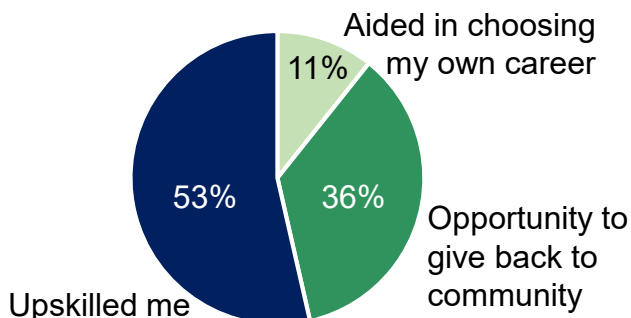
Priority Areas for the Future

- **From rural to urban:** We help students feel comfortable about transitioning to post-secondary education in urban areas, but should also encourage them to return to rural communities.
- **Equity, diversity and inclusion:** Our resources on these areas should be updated.
- **Mentor-mentee knowledge exchange:** Mentors should learn from mentees about rural living.
- **Program structure:** Improve program navigation on the online platform and more accessibility and variety of modules.
