Providing healthcare career mentorship to rural students

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Background: Rural students in British Columbia often do not have equal access to healthcare career mentorship opportunities compared to their urban counterparts.

Methods: We sought to close this gap by providing rural students with virtual access to near-peer mentors throughout their healthcare education.
