## What Is MentorCity?

MentorCity is an online messaging platform specifically designed for mentoring.

It lets you send messages one-on-one with your mentor without sharing personal information like your social media, email address or phone number.

You can access MentorCity through their website on an internet browser or by using the free MentorCity app.

## **How To Login To MentorCity**

- 1) Go to <a href="https://app.mentorcity.com/en/sign\_in">https://app.mentorcity.com/en/sign\_in</a>
- 2) Type in your email and password.
- 3) You will be taken to your dashboard

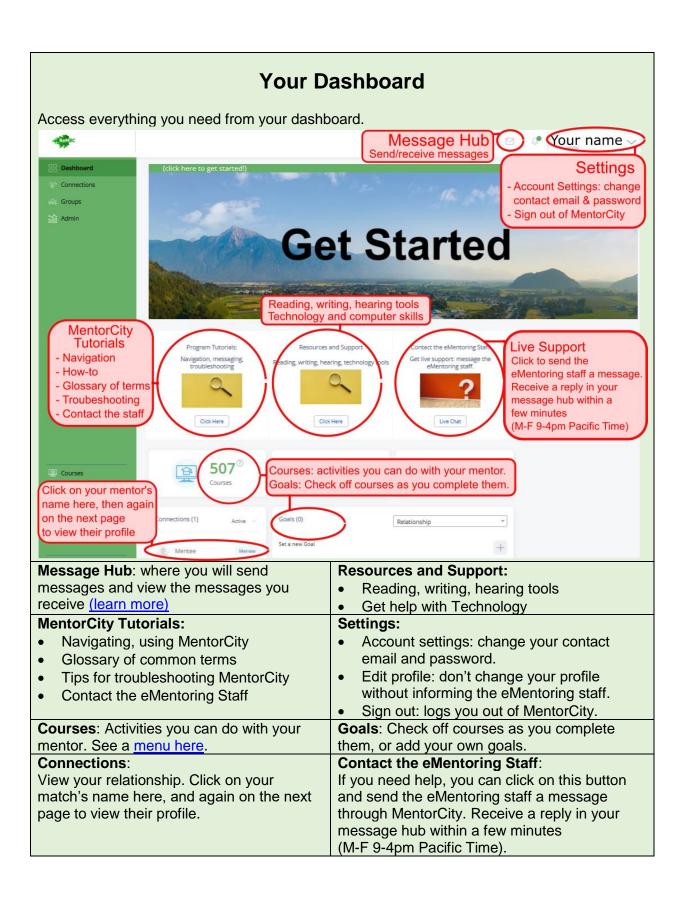

## **Sending and Receiving Messages**

From <u>your dashboard</u>, go to your message hub. Your message hub shows all the messages you have sent and received.



# Don't like writing? Send a video message!

Easily record and send videos in the MentorCity app by clicking the **attach a file button**.

## Sending messages

Type in the **text box** and click the **send button**. Please note:

- Photos cannot be copy/pasted into the text box. You must send them as a file attachment (see "sending files below").
- Text in the text box does not autosave.
  If you must navigate away from the
  message hub, copy/paste your text
  somewhere else so you don't lose it.

#### **Sending Files:**

- 1. Click on the attach a file button
- 2. Navigate to your file
- 3. Click "Open"
- 4. Click the send button

#### **Receiving Messages**

Your match's messages will be on the **left side** of your message hub.

- Your messages will be on the right side of your message hub.
- Oldest messages are at the top.

#### **Viewing Received Files**

- Documents: click on the Document icon to open it. Some documents must be downloaded.
- Videos and pictures: click on the video or picture to view it. It may open in a new window, or enlarge if you are on the app.

A Note on Sharing Content: please properly credit your sources and share responsibly.

- If it's a picture or video that you find online:
  - Make sure it is a public access image or that you have permission to share it.
  - o If necessary, cite your source. Learn how to properly cite an image source
- If it's your own picture:
  - Be mindful of your own and others' privacy no pictures of people's faces without their consent and no pictures of identifying info (like your house number, street name, etc.).
  - Do not share links to your personal Snapchat, Instagram, Facebook, YouTube or other social media platforms.

#### **Courses and Goals**

Courses are activities that give you and your mentor something to talk about.

We have 13 courses, each with different topics. The topics of the courses were suggested by rural students, like yourself, so they cover topics that are useful to YOU. <u>Here's a quick description of each course.</u>

You can do any of the courses in any order, at any time. They are meant to also bring in your mentor's expertise, so let your mentor know which course you are doing so they can follow along.

#### To access the courses

- 1) Click\* on any of the links on your dashboard that says "Courses".
  - \*You may wish to open your courses and message hub in separate tabs or windows. The message hub does not autosave unsent text.
- 2) Then click on the course you desire.

# Goals: Keep track of which courses you have completed

- 1) On your dashboard, click on "Goals".
- 2) Check off courses when you complete them.
- 3) You can also add your own personal goals to the list.

#### **How Courses Work**

Click on "Course Contents" to Navigate to the different activities within a course.

- Warm-up: a quick, optional, activity to get you thinking about the course's topic.
- **Lessons**: each lesson starts with background info about a topic, then choose between doing an Activity and Deliverable with your mentor, or asking your mentor questions about the topic (we have a list of questions you can try, if you get stuck).
  - Portfolio Activity: save your Deliverables in one place, so you can use them for future academic or professional opportunities.
- Extension Activities and Additional Information: optional activities or information to dive deeper into the course's topic.
